HOW DO WE EVALUATE?



1. 'Mentees' complete two surveys: one before and one after the program.



2. We compile and analyse the evaluation responses.



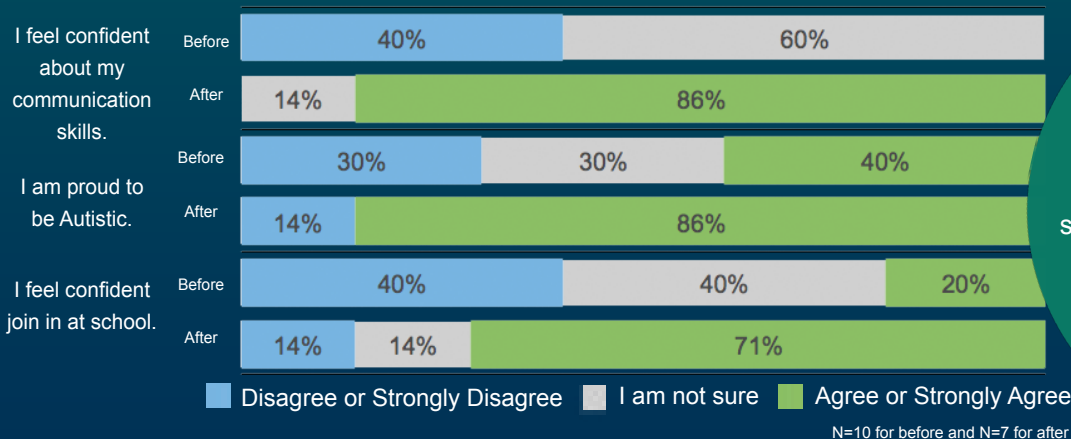
3. We write a report describing the results and outcomes of the program.
