The text below is built into I CAN Network Mentee Registration Forms in which it is consented to by parents/ carers of I CAN mentoring participants. Reminders of the ICT Agreement are shared with young people in actual mentoring sessions.

At I CAN NETWORK LTD we support the right of all participants to access safe and inclusive learning environments, including digital and online spaces. This agreement outlines I CAN Network's roles and responsibilities in supporting safe digital learning, as well as the expected behaviours we have of our participants when using digital or online spaces.

When I use digital technologies, I will communicate respectfully by:

- Being mindful and considerate of others and ensuring what I write or say is polite and respectful
- Being kind to my peers and thinking about how the things I do or say, and how I say them, could make them feel.
- Not sending, forwarding or responding to mean or bullying messages.
- Giving my peers a chance to contribute during the session by being mindful not to monopolise the conversation with my own thoughts and questions.
- Not spamming or using the chat in way that is disruptive to others or to drown out the voices of other participants

When I use digital technologies, I will respect myself, my peers, and our mentors by:

- Only sharing things that are relevant to the topic being discussed.
- Think about how my posts and shares could impact others
- Use spaces or sites that are appropriate and relevant
- Ask the supervising teacher if I need help or support
- Protect and respect private information of both myself and my peers
- Speak to the I CAN Program Facilitator or Supervising Teacher if I see something that upsets me or my peers
- Speak to the I CAN Program Facilitator or Supervising Teacher if someone is unkind to me or my peers
- Not searching for or sharing something rude or violent
- Turn off or close the screen if I see something I'm not comfortable with or that I don't like, and tell the supervising teacher
