'I CAN Imagination Club®' is a mentoring program for primary students who have learning differences or experience social anxiety who may or may not have an Autism diagnosis.



Program Details

- 10-15 x 1-hour sessions, weekly or fortnightly
- Run by two I CAN Mentors
- Program held in a school or interschool

What is Covered?

- Emotional literacy
 - Listening & compromise
- Communication & public speaking
 - Teamwork
 - Team projects

What is Achieved?

- Self-confidence
- Social connections
 - Belonging
 - Self-esteem
- Emotional literacy
 - Social skills
- Communication skills

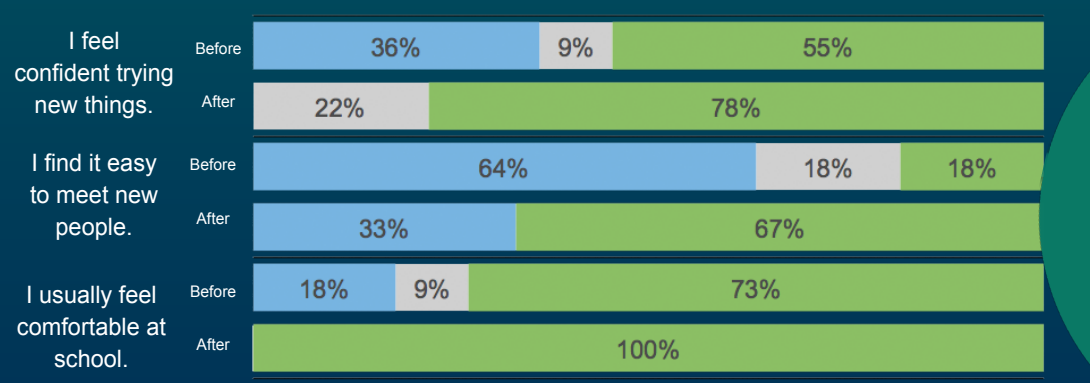
1. 'Mentees' complete two surveys: one before and one after the program.

2. We compile and analyse the evaluation responses.

3. Then we write a report describing the results and outcomes of the program.

WHAT ARE THE RESULTS?

Changes among mentees at Portland Interschool Imagination Club

N=11 for before and N=9 for after

Mentees in an interschool Imagination Club® show improvements in their behaviour, being more self-confident and more sociable. Consequently, mentees felt more comfortable at school, where they could establish connections with their peers and their school.
